Learning Focus

The *Lead the Way* incursion explores what leadership is and practical skills to become better leaders. We explore communication skills, the importance of being trustworthy, role-models, teamwork, empathy, taking initiative and how to make a positive difference.

Through a variety of **interactive activities**, **games**, **discussion**, **stories**, **multi-media**, and **video** the workshop equips students to extend their own skills and the consider the responsibility they play as a leader in their school and beyond.

The *Lead the Way* incursion is recommended for upper primary but can be tailored to meet the needs of students from lower to mid primary. In addition to the student incursion, a complimentary teacher resource manual & curriculum is provided that can be implemented & modified to extend the learning outcomes in the classroom over several weeks.

Key concepts covered in the session:

- Exploring how leadership better enables us to work well within a community
- Each person is unique different people lead in different ways
- Understanding strengths and weaknesses as a leader
- Identifying areas of improvement / development as leaders
- Responsibility how leaders consider others and the consequences of their actions
- Communication skills including public-speaking and facilitation within a smaller group
- How to empower others, be creative and having the courage to take initiative in decision-making
- The importance of having values and goals to work towards
- The power of encouragement and how we can have a positive influence on others
